

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

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October 12, 1929

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. The allowing of claims against the county for the month of September was completed at this meeting as per Allowance Register. No other business of record was transacted at this meeting.

October 16, 1929.

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present.

A committee representing the Douglas County Red Cross Society appeared before the Board in the interest of financial support for a County Health Nurse. On motion of E. J. Hill, seconded by Earl T. Black it was voted by the Board of County Commissioners to grant the same aid for the year beginning Jan. 1930, as was given for the year 1929; namely, an appropriation of \$70 per month for the year.

The matter of issuing Road Bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, to pay for constructing the Emery Road and Westhills Parkway came before the Board for consideration, and there was presented to the Board the certificate of the County Engineer and the County Clerk showing the cost of said improvement to be \$7755.56. The resolution was then read and upon motion of Earl T. Black, seconded by E. J. Hill, was adopted, the vote being: Aye: X. J. Kennedy, Earl T. Black, E. J. Hill

The resolution adopted as aforesaid is as follows:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF COUNTY ROAD BONDS

Whereas, there has been duly filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, a petition for the creation of a benefit district and the construction of a road in said benefit district named the Emery Road and Westhills Parkway, and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did at regular meetings of said Board, find the improvement prayed for to be of public utility and necessary, that the respective petition was signed by the requisite number of landowners owning the requisite amount of land in said benefit district described in said petition and the said petition was in all respects in compliance with the provisions and statutes of the State of Kansas; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, find and determine the total cost of said improvement to be the sum of \$7755.56, and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has not heretofore issued any bonds on account of said improvement of Emery Road and Westhills Parkway, said Board does hereby find and determine that it is necessary that said county issue, sell and deliver forthwith its Douglas County Road Bonds in the sum of \$7755 for the purpose of raising funds for said improvement.

Now, therefore, Be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 16 day of October, 1929;

Section 1. That in order to provide to provide funds to pay for the construction of the Emery Road and Westhills Parkway Road there shall be issued and hereby are issued County Road Bonds of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, in the total sum of \$7755. Said issue shall consist of 15 bonds numbered from 1 to 15 inclusive, each of said bonds, except bond No. 1, being in the sum of \$500. Bond No. 1. being in the sum of \$755. All of said bonds shall be dated Nov. 1, 1929, and shall become due serially as follows:

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of 4-3/4 per cent per annum, payable semiannually on May 1, and November 1. Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer in Topeka, Kansas.

Section 2. Said bonds shall be signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk and shall have the seal of said county affixed thereto, attested by the County Clerk, and shall have attached interest coupons signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, attested by the County Clerk, provided, that said signatures on said coupons may be in fac simile.

Section 3. The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the Clerk of said County are hereby authorized and directed to prepare and execute the bonds herein before described, and to procure their proper registration in the office of the County Clerk and in the office of the State Auditor of Kansas, and when so executed and registered, shall be sold and delivered to the purchaser thereof.

Section 4. The proceeds of the sale of said bonds shall be deposited with the County Treasurer in the special fund heretofore provided for the purpose of paying the cost of the improvement hereinbefore described.

Section 5. The full faith, credit and resources of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, shall be and the same are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same mature.
