Bond Resolution Emerge Road.

October 16, 1929. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with ell mem-bers and the County Clerk present. A committee representing the Douglas County Red Gross Society appeared before the Board in the interest of financial support for a County Helth Nurse. On motion of E. J. Hill, seconded by Earl T. Black it was voted by the Board of County Commissioners to grant the same aid for the year beginning Jan. 1930, as was given for the year 1929; namely, an appropriation of \$70 per month for the year

The matter of issuing Road ^bonds of Douglas County, ^kansas, to pay for con-structing the Emery Road and Westhills ^Parkway came before the Board for Consid-eration, and there was presented to the Board the certificate of the County Engineer Olution was then read and upon motion of Earl T. Black, seconded by E. J. Hill, was adopted, the vote being: Aye: X. J. Kennedy, Earl T. Black, E. J. Hill Nog None/ The resolution adopted as a forward to be 37755.

The resolution adopted as aforesaid is as follows:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZINF THE ISSUANCE OF COUNTY ROAD BONDS

Whereas, there has been duly filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, a petition for the creation of a benefit district and the construction of a road in said benefit district named the Emery Road and Westhills Parkwey, and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did at regular meetings of said Board, find the improvement prayed for to be of public

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Déuglas Countyn, Kansas, did at regular meetings of said Board, find the improvement prayed for to be of public utility and necessary, that the respective petition was signed by the requisite number of landowners owning the requisite amount of landin said benefit district described in said petition and tha said petition was in all respects in compliance with the provisions and statutes of the State of Canses; abd Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, find and determine the totel cost of said improvement to be the sum of \$7755.59, and. Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Canses, has not heretofore issued any bonds on account of said improvement of Emery Road and Westhills Parkway, said Board does hereby find and determine that it is necessary that seid countyisue, sell and deliver forthwith its Douglas County Koad Bonds in the sum of \$7755 for the purpose of raising funds for said improvement. Now, therefore, Be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Koad Bonds in the sum of \$7755. Said and Westhills Parkway Road there shall be issued and hereby are issued County Road Bonds of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, in the total sum of \$7755. Said issue shall consist of 15 bonds numbered from 1 to 15 inclusive, each of said bonds, except bond Nol, being in the sum of \$500. Bond No. 1. being in the sum of \$7755. All of said bonds shall be dated Nov. 1, 1929, and shall be county as follows:

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of 4-3/4 por cent per annum, pryable semiannually on May 1, and Novembor 1. Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer in Topeks, "ansas. Section 2. Said bonds shall be signed by the Chairman of thr Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk and shall have the seal of said county affixed thereto, attested by the County Clerk, and shall have attached interest coupons signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, attested by the County Clerk, provoded, that said signatures on said coupons may be in fac simile. Section 3. The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the Clerk of said County are hereby authorized and directed to prepare and execute the bonds herein before described, and to procure their proper registration in the office of the County Clerk and in the office of the State Auditor of Kansas, and when so ex-ecuted and registered, shall be sold and delivered to Section 4. The proceeds of the sale of said bonds shall be deposited with the County Treasurer in the special fund heretofore provided for the purpose of prying the cost of the improvement hereinbefore described.

the cost of the improvement hereinbefore described. Section 5. The full faith , credit and resources of the County of Douglas, State of "ansas, shall be and the same are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same meture.
