January 11, 1930

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with X. J. Kennedy, Chairman, Earl T. Black and E. J. Hill, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. The work of allowing claims against the county for the preceeding month was completed at this meeting.

The application of Mrs. Roma Austill for admission to the State Sanatorium for Tuberculosis, Norton, Kansas, was presented to the Board by Mrs. Emma J. Kennedy, Poor Commissioner. Moved by Earl T. Black, seconded by X. J. Kennedy, that the County assume the expense of Mrs. Austill in the hospital from the time of this order. The motion was unanimously carried.

Moved by Earl T. Black and seconded by E. J. Hill, That owing to the depleted condition of the County General Fund, the official county printing be and is hereby awarded to The Lawrence Democrat at the same schedule of prices as was paid for the year 1929. The motion was unanimously carried.

This being the day advertised to the Elmer Brown road in Sec. 1; T13S; R19E the Board met at the appointed hour and place as Viewers and proceeded to view said petitioned road. The following report was filed:

We, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, acting as viewers of a road petitioned for by Elmer E. Brown and others of Wakarusa Township met, as heretofore determined and ordered by the Board and the beginning point of the road as petitioned for to be established for public use, as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner of the SW 1/4 Section 1, T 13S; R 19 E; thence West to the NW corner of said section, which we would recommend to be established as a Township Road, the width to be 40 feet, all of which is set forth in the Surveyor's report, and damages allowed as follows: Wm. Kelly claimed \$161.20; we allowed \$75; Frank V. and Belle Phillips claimed \$150.00; we allowed \$45.00; No damages were claimed by Elmer E. Brown or James W. Ewers. The route of said road was surveyed under our direction by C. E. Ellerbrook, County Surveyor, assisted by C. E. Redmond and A. Cox, Chainmen.
