The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with Earl T. Black, Chairman, E. J. Hill and X. J. Kennedy, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present.

The matter of issuing Road Bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, for the purpose of raising revenue to pay for the construction of certain petitioned roads in Douglas County, Kansas, came before the Board for consideration, and there was presented to the Board the certificate of the County Engineer and the County Clerk showing the cost of said improvement to be \$31634.87. The resolution was then read, and upon motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by E. J. Hill, was adopted; the vote being as follows: Aye: Earl T. Black, E. J. Hill, X. J. Kennedy; No: None

The resolution adopted as aforesaid is as follows:

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF COUNTY ROAD BONDS

Whereas there has been duly filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, petitions for the creation of benefit districts, and the construction of roads in the respective benefit districts. Namey: Baldwin Road, Lakeview County Road; Lone Star County Road; Clinton County Road; Baldwin-Ottawa Road; Lecompton Hard Surface, or Robert Steele Highway Road. and

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did, at regularly constituted meetings of said Board, find the improvements as prayed for in said petitions to be of public utility and necessary; that the respective petitions were signed by the requisite number of landowners, owning the requisite amount of land in each of the said benefit districts described in their respective petitions; and that said petitions were in all respects in compliance with the provisions and statutes of the State of Kansas. and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, find and determine the total cost of said improvements to be the sum of \$31634.87. and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has not heretofore issued any bonds on account of said improvements, said Board does hereby find and determine that it is necessary that said county issue, sell and deliver forthwith its Douglas County Road Bonds in the sum of \$31600 for the purpose of raising funds for the aforesaid improvements. Now, therefore,

Be It Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 13 day of February, 1930.

Section 1. That in order to provide funds to pay for the construction of the Baldwin Road, the Lakeview County Road, the Lone Star County Road, the Clinton County Road, the Baldwin-Ottawa Road and the Lecompton Hard Surface or Robert Steele Highway Road there shall be issued and hereby are issued County Road Bonds of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, in the total sum of \$31600. Said issue shall consist of 32 bonds, numbered from 1 to 32, inclusive. Each of said bonds, except bond No. 1, being in the sum of \$1000. Bond numbered 1, being in the sum of \$600. All said bonds shall be dated March 1, 1930, and shall become due serially as follows:

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of three and three-fourths per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of January and July of each year after the date hereof until said principal sum shall have been paid, the first interest coupon, however, being due January 1, 1931. Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer at Topeka, Kansas.

Section 2. Said bonds shall be signed by the Board of County Commissioners and by the County Clerk and shall have the seal of said County affixed thereto, attested by the County Clerk, and shall have attached interest coupons signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Clerk, provided that said signatures on said interest coupon may be in facsimile.

The chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to prepare and execute the bonds herein before described, and to procure their proper registration in the office of the County Clerk and in the office of the Auditor of the State of Kansas, and when so executed and registered, shall be sold and delivered to the purchaser thereof.

Section 4. The proceeds of the sale of said bonds shall be deposited with the County Treasurer in a special fund for the purpose of paying the cost of the improvements hereinbefore described.

Section 5. These bonds are issued by said county for the purpose of providing funds for making permanent improvement of public roads in said county by authority and in full compliance with the provisions, restrictions and limitations of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Kansas, including Article 7, Chapter 68; and Article 1, Chapter 10, Revised Statutes, 1923, and section 68-709 Revised Statutes 1923, as amended by Chapter 253, Laws of 1927, and all other provisions of the Laws of said State; and the full faith, credit and resources of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, shall be and the same are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same mature.
