## February 13, 1930

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with Earl lack, Chairman, E. J. Hill and X. J. Kennedy, Commissioners, and the County Black, T. Clerk present.

The matter of issuing Ra d Bonds of Douglas County, Amsas, for the purpose of raising revenue to pay for the construction of certain petitioned roads in Douglas County, Kansas, came before the Board for comsideration, and there was presented to the Board the certificate of the County Engineer and the County Clerk showing the cost of said improvement to be \$31634.87.
