At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, held on March 5, 1930, it was ordered that the County Clerk instruct the County Treasurer in the matter of disbursing the State Highway Benefit District Fund deposited with the County Treasurer for the year 1929, as follows:

 (A). On land within one mile of the highway, you will credit the taxpayer's count with 80% of the benefit tax (principal only) assessed for the year 1929.
 (B). On land more than one mile from the highway, you will credit the taxpayers tax account with the full amount of benefit tax (principal only) assessed for
