March 3, 1930

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month of March with Earl T. Black, Chairman, E. J. Hill and X. J. Kennedy, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. The minutes of the meetings of the Board held on February 3 - 5 - 8 - 13 were read and approved. The only business of record done by the Board on the above date was the allowing of claims against the county, a record of which appears in the allowance record.

March 5, 1930

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with Earl T. Black, Chairman, E. J. Hill and X. J. Kennedy, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance Register.

The matter of disbursing \$16, 647 .93 State Benefit District Refund as provided by Chapter 225 of the Laws of 1929, and on motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by E. J. Hill, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the following order:

To J. P. Metaker, County Treasurer:

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, held on March 5, 1930, it was ordered that the County Clerk instruct the County Treasurer in the matter of disbursing the State Highway Benefit District Fund deposited with the County Treasurer for the year 1929, as follows:

1. Where the taxes assessed for the year 1929 have not been paid in full.
  - (A). On land within one mile of the highway, you will credit the taxpayer's tax account with 80% of the benefit tax (principal only) assessed for the year 1929.
  - (B). On land more than one mile from the highway, you will credit the taxpayer's tax account with the full amount of benefit tax (principal only) assessed for the year 1929.
2. Where the taxes assessed for the year 1929 have been paid in full
  - (A). On land within one mile of the highway, you will refund the taxpayer in cash on presentation of a Special Benefit Refund Warrant issued by order of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Clerk a sum equal to 80% (principal only) assessed for the year 1929.
  - (B) On land more than one mile from the highway, you will refund the taxpayer in cash on presentation of a Special Refund Warrant issued by order of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Clerk the full amount of the Benefit Tax (principal only) assessed for the year 1929
