## BOND RESOLUTION

BOND RESOLUTION Whereas, there has been filed with the Board of Gounty Commissioners of douglas County, Eansas, a petition for the creation of a benefit district, known as the Douglas County Bewer District No. 1, and the construction of a system of severs with-in said Benefit District, and Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners did, at regularly constituted meeting of said Board, find the improvement as prayed for in said petition to be of public utility and necessary; that the petition was signed by the requisite number of Land-owners, owning the requisite amount of land in the benefit district; and, that said petition was, in all respects, in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 165, Laws of 1927, and

Developments in all respects, in compliance with the provisions of Gaster 165, Laws of 1927, and Whereas the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, find and determine the total cost of said improvements to be the sum of \$25976.82; that of this total cost the County has been reimbursed in the sum of \$2506.17 cash payments of assessments made, and the sum of \$1083.59 collected on the first half taxes assessed Bonk Resolution for the year 1929; that the balance due on installments is the sum of \$20587.06; Whereas the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has not heretofore issued any bonds on account of said improvements; said Board does hereby forthwith its Douglas County Improvement Bonds in the sum of \$20500 for the purpose of reising fundefor the aforesaid improvements. Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 12 of March, 1930. Section 1. That in order to provide funds to pay for the construction of a system of sewers in Douglas County Improvements Bonds of the County of Douglas, State of ansas, in the total sum of \$21500. Said bonds shall consist of 41 bonds, numbered from 1 to 41, inclusive, each of said bonds being in the sum of \$500, and all of said bonds hall be dated April 1, 1930, and shall become due serially as follows: Bonds No. 1-2

Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer at Topeka, Kansas. Section 2. Said bonds shall be signed by the Board of County Commissioners and by the County Clerk and shall have the seal of said County affixed, attested by the County Clerk, and shall have attached interest coupons signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Clerk, that said said signatures on said interest coupons may be in facsimile.
