Resolution Authorizing Special Road Improvement Assessment

RESOLUTION.

Whereas, there has heretofore been filed in the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, for the creation of benefit districts and the permanent improvement of roads in said benefit district, namely, Baldwin Road, the Lakeview County Road, Lone Star County Road, the Clinton County Road, Baldwin-Ottawa Road and the Lecompton Hard Surface or Robert Steele Highway Road; and,

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did, at regular meetings of said, find the improvements as prayed for in said petitions to be of public utility and necessary, and ordered said petitioned roads improved, and,

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners find the best of said improvements, distributed 60% to Douglas County; 25% to the Townships liable, and 15% to the respective benefit districts to be as follows:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, finds that the Baldwin Road and the Baldwin-Ottawa Road is chargeable to Palmyra Township; that the Lakeview Road and 4.2 miles of the Lone Star County Road are chargeable to Wakarusa Township; that the Lecompton Hard Surface, or Robert Steele Highway Road is chargeable to Lecompton Township; that the Clinton County Road and 3.75 miles of the Lone Star County Road are chargeable to Clinton Township; that .375 miles of the Lone Star County Road is chargeable to Willow Springs Township; That .625 miles of the Lone Star County Road is chargeable to Marion Township; Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 16th day of July, 1930, that for the purpose of paying for the foregoing road improvement, there be and is hereby assessed against the respective townships the amounts hereinafter set out, namely,

Lecompton Township	1036.04
Palmyra Township	1136.16
Clinton Township	3204.31
Marion Township	233.85
Willow Springs Twp.	140.30

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT EACH PART AND PARCELS OF REAL ESTATE WITHIN THE RESPECTIVE BENEFIT DISTRICTS be and are hereby assessed the amount as set out in the Special Assessment roll on file in the office of the County Clerk.
