The Board of County Commissioners met in special session with E. J. Hill and X. J. Kennedy, Commissioners, and the County Clerk, present. Earl T. Black, Chairman, being in Colorado, E. J. Hill, Vice-Chairman, presided.

This meeting was held for the purpose of giving a final hearing on the special assessments levied July 16, 1930, against real property in Road Benefit Districts as follows: Baldwin Road, Lakeview County Road, Lone Star County Road, Clinton County Road, Baldwin-Ottawa Road and the Lecompton Hard Surface, or Robert Steele Highway Road.

Several persons appeared before the Board to discuss the manner of assessment and plan of payment. Geo. Markley, Chas. Woodward and H. S. Johnson entered the objection on the ground that they were not benefitted by the road in their respective benefit districts. As the petitions for the creation of benefit districts were properly signed, and hearings on the same duly and legally held, the Board made no order to change the assessments made July 16, 1930.
