until it intersects the south line of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 28; T13S; R18E; thence along the south line of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 28; T13S; R18E; in an easterly direction to intersection with the north and south quarter line through Sec. 28; T13S; R18E; thence north on the quarter line to a point about $\frac{3}{8}$ of a mile north of the center quarter corner of Sec. 28; T13S; R18E; thence in a northeasterly direction to the center quarter corner of Sec. 22; T13S; R18E; thence north on quarter section line to a point south of the north line of Sec. 22; T13S; R18E; thence in an east and then northeasterly direction to the town of Clinton (not an incorporated city), a total distance of about 9.19 miles, being the place of ending.

The improvements herein prayed for shall consist of grading, draining and surfacing said road with SAND & GRAVEL, constructed twenty-four feet wide. The County Commissioners to finally determine type and width of said road, provided, that if but one type is specified in the petition, that type of road shall be the one in the petition set forth.

We state that such permanent improvement will be of benefit to said district and of public utility.

The boundaries of the land subject to be taxed for such improvements are included in the Road Benefit District hereby created, and said boundaries are as follows:

Cor. of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 22-13-18; thence east to the intersection with the west right-of-way line of the present Twin Mound County Road; thence following the west and north right-of-way line of the present Twin Mound road to the west limits of the town of Clinton; thence south on town limits to the south right-of-way line of the present Twin Mound road; thence following the south and east right-of-way line of the present Twin Mound road to the intersection with the north line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 22-13-18; thence east to the quarter corner on the east line of sec. 22; 13-18; the place of beginning. The lots and parcels of land to be taxed for such improvements included in said benefit district are as follows:

Which said descriptions are made a part of this petition for the purpose of fixing and defining the territory included in said district and the boundaries thereof.

The improvements herein prayed for are to be paid from not less than ten or more than twenty annual assessments, to be determined by the Board of County Commissioners, to be levied upon the land above described constitute said Road Benefit District, and from all other funds provided by law for such purpose.

We further request your honorable body to find and declare said road improvement to be of public utility by order of your Board and to make an order that said improvements be made and paid for and that all necessary action therefor be taken as prescribed in chapters 80, 264 and 265, Laws of 1917; and chapters 245, 98 and 246, Laws of 1919; and chapters 213, 214, 215, and 216, Laws of 1925; chapters 251, 252, 253, 255, Laws of 1927; and any amendments thereto.
