The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. The Board completed the allowing of claims for this session. No other business of record was transacted at this meeting

April 15, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present.

The Board of Commissioners entered into contract with Wm. Tuttle of Lawrence, Kansas, whereby said Wm. Tuttle agrees to paint all windows and doorways of the Court House two coats of paint, putty all glass where needed, to varnish doors two coats, all to be done with standard material.

There was presented to the Board a petition signed by C. C. Gerstenderger and others for the location of a road described as follows: Beginning at a point .227 chains north of the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 8; T 13 S; R 21 E; thence north in and along the west line of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said section 8 to the northwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said section 8, and terminating therein.

The above petition being found legal and in due form it is ordered by the Board of County Commissioners that the prayer of the petition for view be granted, that E. J. Hill, Earl T. Black and X. J. Kennedy be and hereby are appointed viewers and are directed to meet at the place of beginning of the above described road on May 15, 1931 at 2 o'clock P.M. and proceed to view said petitioned road and to give all interested parties a hearing. The county clerk was directed to give the proper legal notice of said view.

RESOLUTION

Now, and on this 15 day of April, 1931, the same being one of the regular April 1931 meeting days of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, the Board of County Commissioners being duly assembled in the court house, Lawrence, Kansas, find,

That there has been filed with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, a petition signed by twenty per cent (20%) of the qualified electors of Douglas County, Kansas, petitioning the Board of County Commissioners to adopt the benefits of the County Road Unit System.

It is, therefore, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, Resolved that the benefit of the County Road Unit System be and is hereby adopted by Douglas County as provided by section 68-516, 1930 Supplement of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for 1923, and as provided in Chapter 224 of the session Laws of Kansas for 1929
