RESOLUTION LEVYING A SECIAL ASSESSMENT FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENT

Whereas, the Board of County Commiddioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did, in accordance with a benefit district petition filed in the office of the County Clerk, permanenly improve a certain road in Douglas County, Kansas, known as the Twin Mound Road (County Road), and fully described in said petition; And, Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have found and determined the total cost of said improvement to be the sum of \$9506.44, which total cost is hereby distributed 60%, or \$5703.36, to Douglas County; 25%, or \$2376.61, to Clinton and Marion Townships, in the porportion of \$1238.30 to Clinton Township and \$1138.31 to Marion Township; and j5%, or \$1425.97, to the Benefit District, distributed to the several tracts of real estate within said benefit district at the rate of \$\$/ 2. 742513 mills on the dollar valuation as shown by the assessment rolls for the year 1930, maximum summing and standard stan

THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 11th day of July, 1931, that in accordance with the foregoing distribution of the cost of improving the Twin Nound Read (County Read), there be, and is hereby assessed against the tangible property, personal and real estate, of Douglas County the sum of \$5703.86; against tangible property. personal and real estate, of Clinton Township the sum of \$1236.30; against the tangible property, personal and real estate, of Marion Township the sum of \$1138.31; and against the real estate within the Benefit District the sum of \$1425.97, distributed to each part, parcel or tract within said benefit district at the rate of 2.742513 mills on the dollard valuation as shown by the assessment rolls for the year 1930; The County Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to extend said on the tax rolls of Douglas County as the same becomes due and payable.
