

August 12, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present.

A delegation from Eudora Township appeared before the Board to urge the construction and improvement of a road petitioned for by C. C. Gerstenberger and others that they might have a direct outlet to State Highway No. 10.

The Board of County Commissioners, the County Engineer and the County Clerk went to Lakeview for lunch, after which certain road improvements in that vicinity were inspected.

In the afternoon delegations from the Home Demonstration and 4 H Club departments of the Farm Bureau appeared before the Board and explained something of the nature and extent and value of their work throughout the county.

This being the last day of the Board's established time for their regular and the tax levy for the taxing year not having been fully determined, it was moved by Mr. Black and seconded by Mr. Kennedy, That this regular session be continued to Monday, August 17, 1931 at 2 o'clock P. M. for the purpose of finally determining the tax levies for the coming taxing year.

## TAX LEVY RESOLUTION . 1831

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in adjourned regular session this 17th day of August, 1931, that, for the purpose of raising revenue for the taxing year 1931, there be and is hereby levied on all the tangible taxable property in Douglas County, Kansas, taxes as follows and for the purposes indicated, such taxes represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar valuation as set out below.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for the purpose of paying tuition of pupils in highschools during the current taxing year, based on the estimate certified by the County Superintendent of Public Instruction, there be and is hereby levied on all tangible taxable property in the County of Douglas, not otherwise taxed for high school purposes, a tax of 1.55 mills on the dollar valuation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for the purpose of raising revenue to pay bonds and interest coming due during the ensuing taxing year, there be and is hereby levied on all tangible taxable property subject thereto the following taxes represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar valuation as follows.
