

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

October 5, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met this 5th day of October, 1931, in regular session for the month of October with E. J. Hill, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and Earl T. Black, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. The minutes of the meetings held September 7, 9, 12, 16, and 17 were read and approved. Claims against the County for the month of September were presented to the Board and allowed as per Allowance Register.

The members of the Board, the County Engineer and the County Clerk inspected road and bridge work being done on K-33, East of Baldwin. The Board also inspected the F. C. Jardon farm on which the City of Baldwin has acquired water rights. Mr. Jardon has asked the State Tax Commission to reduce the valuation of his farm because of the presence of said water right.

October 7, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance Register.

On motion of Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Black, the County Engineer was authorized to purchase a Baker Snow Plow for the sum of \$1350 f.o.b. Lawrence, to be paid for Jan 15, 1932, without interest.

October 12, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance Register.

The Franklin County Board of Commissioners presented to this Board a bill for road work done on a certain described road on the Douglas-Franklin County line in accordance with an agreement between the Boards of Commissioners of the aforesaid counties. The bill amounting to \$----- In as much as this work was done on a township road between Marion Township, Douglas County, and Centropolis Township, Franklin County, the Douglas County Board approved the bill, the County Engineer of Douglas County was directed to send the bill to the Marion Township Board with the recommendation that it be paid.

F. W. Freese, superintendent of the County Home resigned to become effective November 10, 1931, and on motion of Earl T. Black, seconded by X. J. Kennedy, the voted unanimously to appoint J. F. Metsker superintendent with Mrs. J. F. Metsker in charge of the house. The appointment to become effective Nov. 10, 1931.

October 14, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. The matter of the request of F. C. Jardon for a reduction in the assessed valuation of the SW 1/4 of 11.15-20 came before the board for consideration. The Board being fully advised in the matter, by unanimous vote recommended a reduction of \$40 on assessed valuation for the land taken by the City of Baldwin, and the County Clerk was instructed to so inform the State Tax Commission.

On motion properly made and seconded, it was unanimously voted, that owing to the financial condition the county withdraw its support of a county health nurse.

On motion of Mr. Black, seconded by Mr. Kennedy, The Phillips Petroleum Co., was awarded the contract for motor fuel for county use the ensuing year.

October 15, 1931.

The Board of county Commissioners met in special session with E. J. Hill, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and Earl T. Black, commissioners and the County Clerk present. This meeting was called for the purpose of receiving and opening bids on West Hills paving project as advertised in the official county paper under date of September 24, 1931. The hour of 10.30 o'clock having arrived the meeting was called to order and the clerk was directed to open and read the bids. The bidders and bids were as follows:
