

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

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December 7, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month of December with E. J. Hill, Chairman, Earl T. Black and X. J. Kennedy, Commissioners and the County Clerk present.

The minutes of the Boards' meeting held November 2, 4, 7, and 10 were read and approved. Claims against the County were presented and allowed by the Board as per Allowance Register.

December 9, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. No business of record other than the allowing of claims as per Allowance Record, was transacted at this meeting.

December 12, 1931.

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. The Board completed the allowing of claims for this session.

On motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by Earl T. Black the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Superintendent of the County Farm & Home is required to make sundry purchases of supplies from time to time when it is expedient and a saving to the county that said purchases be paid in cash, and there being no fund established for this purpose.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 12 day of December, 1931, that the sum of Two Hundred Dollars be placed in the hands of J. F. Metsker, Superintendent of the County Farm as a purchasing fund from which such cash purchases as deemed expedient may be made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY FARM shall render an accounting, monthly, to the Board of County Commissioners of the amounts spent from this fund, and file his claim for said amount so spent, said claim when allowed to be credited to the purchasing fund hereby created.

This resolution shall be the County Clerk's authority, and he is hereby directed to issue County Warrant No. 5969, Series 26, on the County Farm & Poor Fund to J. F. Metsker for the sum of Two Hundred Dollars.

January 4, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month of January with E. J. Hill, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and Earl T. Black, Commissioners, and the County Clerk, present. The minutes of the Boards' meetings held December 7, 9, 12 and 16, 1931, were read and approved.

Claims against the county were presented and allowed as per Allowance Register. Refund warrants were ordered issued as follows: No. 589 in the amount of \$2.96 to the Continental Oil Company because of an erroneous assessment of personal property in the City of Lawrence. Refund Warrant NO. 590 in the amount of \$21.84 to Grace E. Hausam on account of an erroneous assessment of personal property in Baldwin City.

January 6, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the county clerk present. No business of record, other than the allowing of claims, was transacted at this meeting.

January 9, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the county clerk present. The Board completed the allowing of claims for this session.

On motion by Earl T. Black, seconded by X. J. Kennedy, the Board, by unanimous vote, purchased a one-half ton Ford Truck for use on the County Farm for the sum of \$500 and two discarded Ford cars from the road department.

On motion duly made and carried the Board ordered that the County Clerk instruct the County Treasurer to cancel 1931 taxes as set out in Commissioners Order No. 2 for the taxing year 1931.
