The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month February with X. J. Kennedy, Chairman, Earl T. Black and E. J. Hill, Commissioners and the County Clerk present.

The minutes of the Board's meetings held January 4 - 6 - 9 and 13, 1932, were read and approved. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance Register.

On motion of E. J. Hill, seconded by Earl T. Black, the Board by unanimous vote directed the County Clerk to instruct the County Treasurer to transfer \$15,914.70 from the County-Township Road Fund to the County Road Fund.

On motion of E. J. Hill, seconded by Earl T. Black, the following refund warrants were ordered issued:

No. 591, for \$1.98 to Albert Neese on account of overpayment of special assessment on Twin Mound Sanded Road.

No. 592, for \$5.35 to G. E. Cadwell on account of erroneous assessment of a valuation of \$300 for improvement on the W 50 A, of the W 100 A. of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 18-14-20 that did not exist during the taxing year 1930.

## RESOLUTION

A resolution authorizing the grading, curbing, guttering, paving and otherwise improving Indiana Street from the City limits north a distance of three hundred seventy six (376) feet along the line of the west city limits to sixteenth street.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS

SECTION 1. That it is expedient and a public necessity to improve Indiana street along the west city limits from the north city limit line in the sixteenth hundred block a distance of 376 feet north to 16th street in accordance with plans and specifications to be prepared by the city engineer, and the cost of said improvement chargeable to within the City of Lawrence, Kansas, shall be paid by the property within the benefit district herein after designated in ten equal assessments duly certified to the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, according to law.

SECTION 2. Be it further resolved that the benefit district to be charged with that portion of the cost of said improvement, chargeable within the City of Lawrence, Kansas, shall be the following described land:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Block 1, University Place, an addition to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, thence East one hundred thirty-nine and one-half (139 1/2) feet; thence north 398 feet to the south line of 16th street; thence west 137.3 feet; thence south 88 feet, thence east 18 feet, thence south 308 feet to point of beginning.

SECTION 3. Be it further resolved that this resolution be duly certified to the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and thereafter if declared a public necessity by said Board of County Commissioners, notice be given to all interested persons by publication, all in accordance with Chapter 100, Laws of Kansas for 1927.
