

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

March 7, 1931

The Board of County Commissioners met regular session for the month of March with X. J. Kennedy, Chairman, Earl T. Black and E. J. Hill, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. The minutes of the meetings held during February were read and approved.

Claims against the County were presented to the Board and allowed as per Allowance Register,

The Board of County Commissioners sitting as a canvassing Board received the returns of elections held March 1, 1932, by the Mud Creek Drainage District and by the Maple Grove Drainage, and upon canvassing said poll books found the following to be result of said elections:

F. W. Ousdahl, Sam Hall and C. B. Young were elected Directors of the Mud Creek Drainage District; and Frank Fox, Vernon M. King and T. C. Wilkerson were elected Directors of the Maple Grove Drainage District.

March 9, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. Claims against the county were present and allowed as per Allowance register.

On motion properly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board authorized the purchase of the following equipment: to be paid for out of the Bridge Fund. From the Hamilton Motor Co. a one and one-half ton Ford dump truck for \$884.25 From Smith-Williams Motor Co. a one and one-half ton Ford dump truck for \$700, this truck having been used as a demonstrator.

March 12, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. The Board completed the allowing of claims against the county for this session.

The Board sitting as a canvassing board canvassed the returns of an election held March 8, 1932, by the Wakarusa, Haskell, Eudora Drainage District for the election of directors for said drainage district and found that C. Shepherd, Chas Whedon and Ed S. Harvey had received the greatest number of votes cast, and said C. Shepherd, Chas. Wedon and Ed S. Harvey were declared duly elected directors of said drainage district for the ensuing term.

March 16, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the county clerk present.

The matter of locating a road in Eudora Township as petitioned by C. C. Gerstenberger and 16 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners April 15, 1931, came before the Board for further consideration. It being found that the action had on said petition was not entirely regular and complete, the Board directed the County Clerk to readvertise said petition by giving legal notice as required by law and set April 6, 1932, at 1.30 o'clock as the time when the Commissioners, as viewers, would meet at the place of beginning of said petitioned road to give all interested parties a hearing.

The minutes of the proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners at their meetings held during the month of March, 1932, were read and approved this 4th day of April, 1932,
