

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. The Board completed the allowing of claims for this session/

The Board ordered the cancellation of the following tax sales for the reason that the real estate therein describe was doubly assessed.

Sale No. 260, 1928 taxes, \$234.73

Sale No. 321, 1929 taxes, \$243.18

A petition signed by W. H. Johanning and fourteen other resident householders of this county asking the Board of County Commissioners to cause a view to be had for the vacation of the following described road: Beginning at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between sections 29 and 20; T14S; R19E; thence North on center section line to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between 20 and 17; T14S; R19E, formerly road No. 385, and terminating at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between sections 20 and 17, T14S, R19E, came before the Board for consideration. The petition being found in due and regular form and the proper bond being signed, the Board set May 4, 1932, at 1.30 P.M. to view said road, and directed the County Clerk to make legal publication of said view.

On motion properly made and seconded the following resolution was adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, and the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, sitting as a joint board for this purpose.

## RESOLUTION

Be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, sitting as a joint board for the purpose of this resolution and of the subject matter thereof and for the purpose therein expressed, that inasmuch as on April 4, 1932, the said Board of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, duly passed its resolution declaring the grading, curbing, guttering, paving, or otherwise improving East 15th street in the city of Lawrence, and East 15th Street extended, unnecessary, improvident, not of public utility or necessity and inexpedient, because of the reasons and the matters set out in said resolution and particularly of the change in conditions therein set out and did rescind their action of March 26, 1928, and which resolution was unanimously passed by said board on April 4, 1932, and a certified copy thereof duly transmitted to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on said day, and that thereupon the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did duly and fully approve and confirm said resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the city of Lawrence, Kansas, and did thereupon pass a resolution of said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, declaring the grading, curbing, guttering, paving, or otherwise improving of East 15th Street in the city of Lawrence and East 15th street extended, unnecessary, improvident, not of public utility or necessity and inexpedient, and did rescind its action of date March 26, 1928, which said resolution was passed April 4, 1932, by the action of said Board of County Commissioners by two of its three members and both of which resolutions aforesaid were duly recorded on the minutes of both bodies aforesaid.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the aforesaid Board of Commissioners of the city of Lawrence, Kansas, and the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, in joint session and acting in unison, that the above resolutions of April 4, 1932, of both said bodies be adopted, approved and confirmed, and that this joint Board does here and now declare the grading, curbing, guttering, paving or otherwise improving East 15th street, Lawrence, Kansas and East 15th street extended and the highway produced east therefrom beginning at the end of the present pavement on East 15th street at its intersection with Barker Avenue thence east along the highway lying partly within and partly without the city of Lawrence to the east city limits located at the common corner between sections 31 and 32, T12, R20, and sections 5 and 6, T13, R20, in Douglas County, Kansas, and thence eastward for a distance of five-eighths of a mile, unnecessary, improvident, not of public utility or necessity and inexpedient, and does hereby and now rescind, vacate and annul its former action and resolution passed in and about said matter of paving East 15th street in the city of Lawrence, and East 15th street extended, and of date June 6, 1928, and said resolution of June 6, 1928, is hereby rescinded and revoked intoto, together with all amendatory resolutions thereto and passed in connection therewith.
