Johanning Road Vacated
The Board of County Commissioners acting as VIEWERS met as heretofore ordered by the Board at the beginning point of the road sought to be vacated as petitioned by W. H. Johanning and others and advertised in the official paper April 21, 1932, and proceeded to view said road and gave all interested parties a hearing. the viewers found the road as existing to be impracticable and of no convenience to the public and therefor recommend that it be vacated.

On motion of Earl T. Black, seconded by E. J. Hill that the following described road be and is hereby vacated, Beginning at the 1/4 corner between sections 29 and 30, T14S, R19E, thence north on 1/2 section in section 20 to the quarter corner between section 20 and 17, T14S, R19E, formerly Road No. 385, and terminating therein. The motion was then put by the chairman, and unanimously carried.

Hedges
On motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by E. J. Hill, and unanimously carried the hedge fences along what is known as the Markley Road in Willow Springs Township was declared a nuisance, and the township board was directed to remove such hedge when found detrimental to such road.
