

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that that for the purpose of raising revenue for the maintenance of sewers in Douglas County Sewer District No. 1, a district outside the corporate limits of a city, and for the purpose of reimbursing Douglas County for money expended, there be and is hereby levied on all real estate, exclusive of improvements, within said Douglas County Sewer District No. 1, a tax of one dollar on the hundred dollar valuation of said real estate, exclusive of improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the purpose of raising revenue to pay bonds and interest of the several taxing district comin due the ensuing taxing year, and for which the Board of County Commissioners are by law required to levy, and for the purpose of reimbursing Douglas County for money expended, there be abd are hereby levied the following taxes represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar valuation of all tangible taxable property in the taxing district liable therefor, Namely:
