BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AS BOARD OF CANVASSERS November 11, 1932

Pursuant to law the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk met as a canvassing board for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the General Election held November 8, 1932. The hour of ten o'clock A. M. having arrived and a majority of the Board of County Commissioners being present, the County Clerk presented the poll books of the several election district of the county for the General Election held November 8, 1932, the Board did then proceed to canvass said returns according to law. The Board was occupied during November 11, 12, and 14 in canvassing the General Election returns of the county. November the 15, the Board was in session for the purpose of counting the in-state absentee voter, and on December 5, the Board met in final session and counted the votes returned by electors out of the state on November 8, 1932. The findings of the Board were duly recorded in the official abstract of election returns and there duly certified to.

The Board did then adjourn sine die. Witness our hands this 5 day of December, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month of december with X. J. Kennedy, Chairman, Earl T. Black and E. J. Hill, commissioners, and the County Clerk present. The minutes of the meetings held Nov. 7, 9, 12 and 16 were read and approved, Claims against the county were allowed as per Allowance Register

December 7, 1932

the Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the county clerk present. Claims were allowed as per Allowance register.

Mr. Will Griesa presented a landscape plan for the County Home. The Board took the plan under consideration.

The Board directed the County Clerk to instruct the County Treasurer to make transfers of funds as follows: Transfer from the County-Township Road Fund to the County Road Fund the sum of \$10,564.37, Transfer from the County Fund to the County General Fund the sum of \$842.20. Transfer from the Crippled Childrens Fund to the County General Fund the sum of \$2500. , being the unexpended balance in this fund for the year 1931.

A refunding warrant in the sum of \$18,32.97 was granted the M. E. Church of Eudora on account of an erroneous assessment of the N 42 feet of Lot 4, Block 181 in Eudora City. for the years 1929, 1931 and 1932.

December 10, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the county clerk present. Claims against the county were allowed as per Allowance Register.

On motion of Earl T. Black, seconded by E. J. Hill, the Board ordered that the County Clerk direct the County Treasurer to cancel penalties, interest and advertising on special taxes for the year 1930 and 1931 charged against Fraternity and sorority property, the general taxes in controversy in court.

December 14, 1932

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the county clerk present. The Board completed the allowing of claims for this session. No other business of record was transacted at this meeting.

The minutes for the month of December, 1932 were read and approved Jan. 3, 1933.
