

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

January 3, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session with X. J. Kennedy, Chairman, Earl T. Black, and E. J. Hill, Commissioners, and the county clerk present. The minutes of the meetings held during the month of December, 1932, were read and approved.

The petition of L. A. Muffer and others for the vacation and location of certain roads in sec 5, T13S, R20E, was presented to the Board. Action on the petition was deferred.

The application of the Modern Woodman Lodge at Baldwin for expection of their real estate from general taxation was received by the Board, and said petition was forwarded to the State Tax Commission with the recommendation that the prayer of the petition be denied as the property in question does not come within the law regarding the right to exemption.

By authority of Chapter 68-114 R. S. 1923, the Board ordered the rounding of corners on Road No. 185-185 $\frac{1}{2}$  between 5 & 8 and 8 & 9 T18S. R20E. The Board also ordered an alueration in the Stull Road between Sec.30 & 31, T12S. R18E.

The Board allowed claims against the county as per Allowance Register

January 4, 1933

The Board met in adjourned regular session with all members present. Claims against the county were presented and allowed as per Allowance Register.

The Board spent the afternoon in inspecting roads and bridges and proposed work to be done. In the matter of proposed channel change on the Stony Point Road the Board allowed damages of \$15 for the land describes as follows: Beginning at a point 65 feet east 30 feet south of the NW. corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 21, T14S, R20E, Thence East parallel to the north line of said  $\frac{1}{4}$  section, 240 feet; thence South 25 feet; thence West parallel to the North line of said  $\frac{1}{4}$  section, 240 feet; thence north 25 feet to point of beginning, Containinf .14 A. more or less.

January 7, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with X.J. Kennedy, Chairman, Earl T. Black and E. J. Hill, Commissioners, and the county clerk present. The Board allowed claims against the county as per Allowance Register..

The claim of St Margarets Hospital, Kansas City, Kansas, in the amount of \$32.00 for care of Mrs. Cecile Mayhugh was not allowed by the Board. The county clerk was directed to return the claim informing the Hospital that Mrs. Mayhugh was not a resident of Douglas County.

The Board adopted the following resolution adding to the County Road System.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Lake View County Highway has no direct connection another county highway or state highway but terminates at the west end of Fourth street on the west city limits of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and

WHEREAS, it would be a great convenience to the travelling public to have a direct connection with U. S. No. 40 paved highway.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, in regular session assembled this 7 day of January, 1933, that the following described section of the old Quindaro-Salina Territorial Road be designated as a County Road and the same be added to the present system of county highways: to-wit, Beginning at a point 16.5 feet East of the S. W. corner of the S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 26, T 12 S., R 19 E., which point is in the U. S. 40 Highway, thence North 23 d, 11 min. E 725.3 feet to the P. C. of an 3d curve; thence around said curve 381.25 feet to P. T.; thence north 53d. 41 min. 73.2 feet to a point in the West line of Sec. 26, T12E. R19E, 1539.6 feet North of the S.E. cor. of said section 26., thence North along the East line of said section 26. and terminating in the West end of Fourth Street, on the West city limits of the City of Lawrence, which point is the south termination of the present Lake View County Highway.

January 11, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with X. J. Kennedy, Chairman, Earl T. Black, Commissioner, James F. Brass, the newly elected commissioner from the Third District, and the County Clerk present. The Board organized for the ensuing year by electing Earl T. Black, Chairman, and X. J. Kennedy, Vice-Chairman.

The application of Mrs. M. J. Briggs, 3912 Paseo Blvd., Kansas City, Mo., for cancellation of penalty and advertising on lots in Block 53 West Lawrence, was denied.

The Board ordered a refunding warrant issued to the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Ry Co., in the amount of \$273.68, said amount being paid under protest on a levy made by School District 78 $\frac{1}{2}$ , which levy was declared by the State Tax Commission to excessive.

The Board ordered a refunding warrant issued in favor of Ralph Ward in the sum of \$14.76 tax on a tract of land erroneously listed as Reserve in Home Wood Gardens the same being assessed in 5-13-20.
