## February 6, 1933

February 0, 1955 The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month of February with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James F. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. The minutes of the meetings of the Board of Comô missioners held January 2,  $\frac{4}{2}$ , 7, and 11, 1933, were read and approved. Claims against the county were allowed as per Allowance Register,

The Board , after due investugation , found that there had been paid for Bounty an amount in excess of the amount raised by levy for this purpose, did, on motion by. Kennedy , seconded by Brass, ordered the payment of bounty discontinued.

On Motion vy Kennedy, seconded by black, the county clerk was directed to instruct the county treasurer to make transfers of the following funds: Transfer from the Crippled Childrens Fund to the County General Fund the sum of \$151.78, this amount being the balance in Grippled Childrens fund Dec.31,1932. \$5282.18, Deing the county's Share of the state allotment for the fourth iquarter of 1932.

Transfer from the Bounty Fund to the County General Fund the sum of\$1015.64 to reinburse the general fund for bounty paid

No further business appearing the Board, on motion properly made and seconded, adjourned to Feb. 15,1933.

#### February 15, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met this 15 day of February, pursuant to adjourn-ment of Feb. 11, 1933, with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X.J.Kennedy and James F. Brass, Commissioners, and the county clerk present.

The Board having previously advortised for proposals to do the County Official printing for the year beginning March 1, 1933, and proposals having been filed by The Lawrence Democrat, The Douglas County Republican, The World Company, and the Baldwik Ledger, the Board considered these proposals, and accepted the proposal of the World Co.(The Lawrence Daily JournalsWorld) at 30 cents per square of 250 ems insertion for all official county printin, including the delinquent and final Tax notice, and on motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by James F, Brass The Lawrence Daily Journal-World was designated as the official county paper for the ensuing year beginning Karch 1, 1933.

On motion properly made and seconded , the Bcard adopted the following resolution.

#### RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the county commissioners hereby accept the proposal of the Governor of Kansas for the establishment and operation of an emergency relief fund from federal emergency relief funds for the payment of work relief wages on Work Relief Project No. 16-13 entitles "Cutting Tress at County Farm".

That there is hereby established a fund entitled "The Emergency Relief Fund, Segtion 2. Section 2. That there is hereby established a fund entitled "The Emergency Relief Fund in which the county treasurer shall keep any monies coming into his hands for such fund, and he shall keep it in the same manner as he keeps the other funds of the county, and he shall be liable for the safe keeping and proper application of said mergency relief funds to the same extent as the other funds of the county. The financial officers of the county are hareby directed and required to do all the thing Kansas Federal Relief Committee pertaining to the same. things
