March 15, 1933

Pursuant to adjournment of March 11, 1933, the Board of County Commissioners met this 15 day of March, 1933, with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James F. Brass, Commissioners, and the county clerk present. The Board completed the following claims for this session.

The Board of County Commissioners <sup>made</sup> a supplementary request to The Kansas Federal Relief Committee for an additional \$500 for Work Relief Project 16-13, and an additional \$3000 for Work Relief Project 16-7 Project 16-13 is Cutting timber on the County Farm. Project 16-7 is Quarrying and Crushing Rock.

On motion by Bss, seconded by Kennedy, the Board directed the County Clerk to instruct the County Treasurer to transfer from the Fort to Fort Bond and Interest to the State Benefit District Refund Account the sum of \$78.98, said sum being the amount necessary to cover outstanding warrants drawn on the State Benefit District Refund account.
