

## Minutes of April 12, 1933, Continued

The petition of Fred Gregory and others for the location of a road beginning at the center quarter corner of Sec. 36, T 12 S, R 18 E, thence North one-half mile to the quarter corner on the North line of said Sec. 36, and terminating in U. S. Highway 40 was presented to the Board. No action was taken on the petition

On motion made and carried the Treasurer was instructed to mark void or cancelled all warrants that have not been returned for payment for a period on three years from date of issue.
