

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners met on the 17 day of September, 1931, as provided in the above mentioned publication, and there being no protests, complaints, or written objections to the proposed improvements therein set out, and the Board being fully advised in the matter, granted the prayer of the petition and directed the County Clerk to advertise for bids on the proposed improvements in accordance with plans and specifications furnished by the Engineer.

Whereas, pursuant to notice published in the Official County Paper, September 24, 1931, the Board of County Commissioners did, on October 15, 1931, contract with M. N. Penny, Lawrence, Kansas, to do the road improvement as specified.

Whereas, said road improvement has been completed in accordance with the Engineer's plans and specifications, the Board of County Commissioners find the total cost of West Hills Terrace, being one of the roads to be improved, is \$2,708.50, and that said Board of County Commissioners further find that the total front footage of said West Hills Terrace road to be 624.58 feet, and that the cost per front foot of said West Hills Terrace be \$4.336514, and,

Whereas, the District Court of Douglas County, Kansas, in a certain judgment rendered in said Court on the 14 day of January, 1933, did enjoin this Board of County Commissioners from making an assessment on Lot Number One (1), Block Number One (1), of West Hills in accordance with a resolution levying a special assessment made by the Board of County Commissioners on the 11 day of May, 1932, as recorded on page 101 of Commissioner's Record "M".

NOW THEREFORE, we, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 13 day of September, 1933, and in accordance with section 68-728, 1930 Supplement to the Revised Statutes of Kansas for 1923, do hereby reassess Lot Number One (1), Block Number One (1), West Hills, said Lot Number One (1) Block Number One (1), being the land abutting on West Hills Terrace, in accordance with a registered plat on file in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, the following amount to be paid in not more than ten (10) equal installments, with interest from the first day of July, 1932.

LOT NUMBER ONE (1), BLOCK NUMBER ONE (1), WEST HILLS TERRACE, A ROAD IN WEST HILLS DISTRICT, A PLATIES DISTRICT ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, Front footage, 171 1/2 feet, Assessment, \$743.712151

On motion of James F. Brass, seconded by X. J. Kennedy, the Board adjourned to September 27, 1933.

September 27, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with X. J. Kennedy and James F. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present at the opening of the meeting. Earl T. Black having been delayed from being present at the opening of the meeting. Mr Black arrived later in the day.

On motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by James F. Brass, the County Treasurer was instructed as follows:

To cancel personal tax in the amount of \$3.02 on account of an erroneous assessment against Russell Schon of Wakarusa Township

To transfer from the Bounty Fund to the County General Fund the sum of \$1167.14 to reimburse the General Fund for money paid out on bounty.

To transfer from the Gasoline Refund Account to the County Road Fund the sum of \$234.41, the Gasoline Refund being a dead account.

To transfer from the County-Township Road Fund to the County Road Fund the sum of \$5347.64, said sum being the second quarterly appropriation of the State Highway Fund.

This being the day set for a final hearing on the special assessment against Lot One, Block One West Hills on account of West Hills Terrace Road, and the hour of 10 o'clock A. M. having arrived, and no complaints or protests having been made or written objection having been filed, and the Board having been fully advised in the matter, and on motion of James F. Brass, seconded by X. J. Kennedy approved the Assessment of \$743.71 against Lot One, Block One, West Hills, as made by the Board of County Commissioners on September 13, 1933

On motion of James F. Brass, seconded by X. J. Kennedy, the Board adjourned the September session.
