

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

October 2, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session this 2nd day of October, 1933, with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy, and James P. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. The minutes of all meetings held during the month of September, 1933, were read and approved. Claims against the county were audited and allowed as per Allowance Register. No other business of record was transacted at this meeting. On motion of Kennedy, seconded by Brass, adjournment was taken to October 4, 1933.

October 4, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session, pursuant to adjournment taken on Oct. 2, 1933, with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James P. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. No business of record was transacted at this meeting other than the allowing of claims against the County. On motion the Board adjourned to October 7, 1933.

October 7, 1933.

Pursuant to adjournment taken October 4, 1933, the Board met in adjourned regular session with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James P. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present.

The Board together with the County Engineer, spent some time in inspecting the work being done by the county on Highway #33 in Palmyra Township preparatory for the State Highway Department to add this road to the State System.

Claims against the County were allowed as per Allowance Register. On motion made and carried the Board adjourned to October 10, 1933.

October 10, 1933

Pursuant to adjournment taken on Oct. 7, The Board of County Commissioners met this 10th day of October, in adjourned regular session with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James P. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present.

The official bond of S. S. Learned, County Treasurer Elect, was filed with the County Clerk and approved by the Board of County Commissioners, this being the close of L. E. Hoover's term as County Treasurer, the County Clerk administers the oath of office to S. S. Learned as County Treasurer for the term beginning Oct. 10, 1933. Mr Learned presented Roy W. Parker as his Deputy, and the oath of office to him as such.

Bids for printing the 1934 Tax Rolls were opened by the Board and were as follows:

On motion of James P. Brass, seconded by Earl T. Black the contract was awarded to Dodsworth Stationery Co, for the sum of \$162.50 by a unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by James P. Brass, the Board adjourned the October session.

November 6, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session this 6th day of November, 1933, with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James P. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. The minutes of the meetings held during the month of October were read and approved.

Claims against the county were audited and allowed as per Allowance Register.

The Board considered bids submitted for furnishing gasoline for county use, and on motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by James P. Brass, all bids were rejected and new bids were called for to be opened November 15, 1933.

Upon the recommendation of Dr. Jones, County Health Officer, the application of A. H. Stirrman for admission to the Tubercular Hospital at Norton, was approved.

Moved by Brass, seconded by Kennedy that adjournment be taken to Nov. 10. Carried

November 8, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session this 8th day November, 1933, with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James P. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk present. Claims against the County were allowed as per Allowance Register. No other business of record was transacted at this meeting.

On motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by James P. Brass, the Board adjourned to to Nov. 10, 1933.

November 10, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James P. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk, present. Additional claims against the county were allowed at this meeting.

The Board, together with the County Engineer, made an investigation the road crossing at what is known as the Hartman corner in Marion Township, and directed the rounding of the Northeast and Southeast corners of this intersection so as eliminate the hazard existing.

Adjournment was taken to November 15, 1933
