Motion of James F. Brass, seconded by X. J. Kennedy, passed: to amend the minutes of October 7, 1933, meeting of the Board of County Commissioners to read as follows:

November 10, 1933

November 10, 1933

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with Earl T. Black, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and James F. Brass, Commissioners, and the County Clerk, present. Additional claims against the county were allowed at this meeting.

The Board, together with the County Engineer, made an investigation the road crossing at what is known as the Hartman corner in Marion Township, and directed the rounding of the Northeast and Southeast corners of this intersection so as eliminate the hazard existing.
