Motion of James F. Brass, seconded by I.J. Kennedy, passed: to amend the minutes of the November 18, 1933 meeting of the Board of County Commissioners to read as follows:

Upon the recommendation of Mary E. Jamison, Poor Commissioner, and subject to the approval of the Kansas Emergency Relief Committee, the Board of County Commissioners on motion of James F. Brass, seconded by I.J. Kennedy, approved the employment of Louis E. Johnson as Operating Supervisor in the office of the Poor Commissioner at the salary of \$18.00 per week, employment to begin November 23, 1933. Said salary to be paid by the Kansas Emergency Relief Committee.
