On motion of James F. Brass seconded by X. J. Kennedy the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, - The State of Kansas is constructing a large lake in Section 14 - T 14 S R 18 E, and

Whereas, - The present Township road described as follows, has been chosen as the principal entrance to said lake, and

Whereas, - Said Township road is narrow, in poor condition and inadequate to accommodate the future traffic that will use this road.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That we the Douglas County Commissioners in regular session assembled, this 10th day of October, 1934, do hereby order said Township road added to the present system of County Highways, for the purpose of construction and maintenance, beginning at the S E Cor of Sec. 13, T 14 S, R 18 E, thence west about seven eighths of a mile, thence north and northwest to intersect with the East line of the State Lake property.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, being in adjourned regular session of the regular October meeting, this 10th day of October 1934, there being present:

The resolution adopted is as follows:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas having made the maximum levy of taxes for the relief of the poor and destitute, and finding said levy insufficient for the purpose levied, they do now find it necessary to issue and sell Emergency Relief Bonds to supplement the funds raised by taxation, and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners, having complied with all the provisions of law governing the issuance of Emergency Relief Bonds, all of which proceedings are fully set out in the attached transcript.

NOW THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in adjourned regular session assembled this 10th day of October, 1934.

That by authority granted in Chapter 67, Special Session of 1933, Laws of Kansas, there shall be, and hereby are issued Emergency Relief Bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars, (\$30,000.00) Said issue shall consist of Sixty (60) Bonds of Five Hundred Dollars, (\$500.00) each, numbered from one to sixty inclusive. All of said bonds shall be dated November 1, 1934, and become due and payable serially as follows:

No.	1 to 6 Inclusive	\$500.00 each, Nov.	1, 1936

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of 3½ per annum, payable on May 1, and November 1 in each year. Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer in Topeka, Kansas. Said bonds shall be signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and by the County Clerk, and shall have the seal of said County affixed thereto, attested by the County Clerk, and shall have attached interest Coupons signed by the
