Section 1. That Emergency Kelief Bonds of Douglas County, Kanses, in the sum of \$30,000.00 be and the same hereby are authorized by virtue of Chapter 67 of the laws of 1933, Special Session, State of Kanses, Article 1, Chapter 10, R. S. Kanses, 1923, and amendments thereto and all other laws of Kanses applicable thereto. Seid issue shall consist of sixty bonds, numbered 1 to 60- inclusively in the denomin of sixty bonds, numbered 1 to 60, inclusively, in the denomination of \$500.00 each. All of said bonds shall be dated November 1, 1934, and become due and payable serially as follows:

FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS in lawful money of the United States of America, on the first day of November with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of three and one-fourth per cent (34%) per mnum, payable semi-annually on the first days of May and November in each year after the date hereof until the said principal sum shall have been paid, upon presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto annexed bearing the facsimile signatures of the Chairman and the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, as said coupons severally become due. both principal end interest of this bond being payable at the office of the State Tressurer of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeks, Kansas. And said County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, is held and firmly bound by these presents, and the full faith, credit and resources of said county are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said principal and interest at maturity. This bond is one of a series of sixty bonds of like date and tenor, excepting maturity, aggregating the principal sum of \$30,000.00, issued by law.
