

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in session duly assembled:

Section 1. That Emergency Relief Bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, in the sum of \$30,000.00 be and the same hereby are authorized by virtue of Chapter 67 of the laws of 1933, Special Session, State of Kansas, Article 1, Chapter 10, R. S. Kansas, 1923, and amendments thereto and all other laws of Kansas applicable thereto. Said issue shall consist of sixty bonds, numbered 1 to 60, inclusively, in the denomination of \$500.00 each. All of said bonds shall be dated November 1, 1934, and become due and payable serially as follows:

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of three and one-fourth per cent ($3\frac{1}{4}\%$) per annum, payable May 1 and November 1 in each year. Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer in Topeka, Kansas. Said bonds shall be signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Clerk, and shall have the seal of said county affixed thereto; and shall have attached interest coupons signed by the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Clerk, but said interest coupons may be authenticated by lithographed facsimile signatures of said officers.

Section 2. Said bonds and the interest coupons thereto attached shall be in substantially the following form:

EMERGENCY POOR RELIEF BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas for value received, hereby acknowledges itself to be indebted and promises to pay to the bearer the sum of

FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS

in lawful money of the United States of America, on the first day of November with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of three and one-fourth per cent ($3\frac{1}{4}\%$) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of May and November in each year after the date hereof until the said principal sum shall have been paid, upon presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto annexed bearing the facsimile signatures of the Chairman and the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, as said coupons severally become due. both principal and interest of this bond being payable at the office of the State Treasurer of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas. And said County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, is held and firmly bound by these presents, and the full faith, credit and resources of said county are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said principal and interest at maturity.

This bond is one of a series of sixty bonds of like date and tenor, excepting maturity, aggregating the principal sum of \$30,000.00, issued by said county for the purpose of relief of the poor in said county as prescribed by law. And it is hereby certified and recited that this bond is issued in full conformity with the provisions, restrictions, and limitations of the Constitution and laws of the State of Kansas and is authorized and issued under authority of Article 3a of Chapter 39, R. S. 1933 Supplement of Kansas and of Article 1 of Chapter 10, R. S. 1923 of Kansas, and all acts amendatory thereof and pursuant to all other laws of said state applicable thereto, and pursuant to the resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and this bond and all other bonds of said series and all interest thereon, are to be paid by said Douglas County, Kansas.

And it is hereby declared and certified that all acts, conditions and things required to be done and to exist precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have been properly done and performed and do exist in due and regular form and manner as required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, and that the total indebtedness of said county, including this series of bonds, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, said county of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, by its governing body has caused this bond to be signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, and attested by the Clerk of said Board and the seal of said County to be affixed hereto, and the coupons hereto attached to be signed, with the facsimile signatures of said officers, and this bond to be dated this _____ day of November, 1934.
