August 6, 1934 and October 10, 1934, shall stand in lieu of
and as a substitution for such provisions in said resolution
heretofore adopted.

Section 5. That all sections of said resolutions heretofore
adopted upon August 6, 1934 and October 10, 1934 which are not
inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this resolution
be and are re-adopted and the same shall stand as originally
adopted.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after
its passage and adoption.
