The meeting was called by the chairman of the joint meeting, James F. Brass as provided for in the adjournment of the joint meeting of February 12, 1935. The minutes of the meeting of February 12, 1935 were read and approved as corrected.

The meeting was called for further consideration of the repairs of the Eudora bridge across the Kaw River at Eudora. After some discussion a resolution was drawn under the authority granted the commissioners of the aforesaid counties by House Bill No. 489 of the 1935 legislature. The resolution follows:

RESOLUTION BY A SPECIAL JOINT SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS AND LEAVENWORTH COUNTIES, KANSAS, PURSUANT TO HOUSE BILL NO. 489, 1935 LEGISLATURE, PROVIDING FOR REPAIR AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE EUDORA BRIDGE.

WHEREAS, the condition of the Eudora Bridge across the Kansas River is in such state of repair that immediate improvement must be made. An emergency does exist in regard to the same and whereas bonds have been authorized to be issued by the counties of Douglas and Leavenworth, not to exceed \$30,000.00 in House Bill No. 489 of the 1935 Legislature.

It is therefore resolved by the Board Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas and Leavenworth Counties in joint special meeting assembled this 4th day of April, 1935 that the engineers of the respective counties be and are hereby directed to immediately prepare plans and specifications for types of repairs to be made; the costs of which are not to exceed the authorized bond issue of \$30,000.00 said plans and specifications to be presented at an adjourned special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of their respective counties for their approval.

It is further resolved that said plans and specifications be prepared for a 16 feet width of said bridge, said width to comply with that part of the bridge now in good repair.
