Now on this fifth day of August, 1935, a Petition having been presented by certain signers in the number of two hundred and seventy-four (274), which this Board now finds to constitute two-fifths (2/5) of the tax payers residing in the District described in the said Petition, and the Board now finds that said Petition conforms in all things to Section 24-403, Revised Statute 1923. Said Petition praying for the incorporation of the Douglas County Kaw Drainage District;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY KANSAS in regular meeting assembled this fifth day of August, 1935, that a hearing for said Petition be now set and fixed for the 12th day of August, 1935 at 10 o'clock a. m., and the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas is hereby authorized to give Notice thereof by one publication in the Lawrence Daily Journal World of Douglas County, Kansas at least five days before the day fixed for this hearing, at which time persons in said District may appear and show cause why said District should not be organized in the manner provided by law.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 5th day of August, 1935, a Petition signed by Wesley E. Bruno, A. B. Conner, Alfred Heck, Emil W. Heck, F. V. Lewis, W. R. Stiner, and others to the number of two hundred and seventy-four (274), was presented to the Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County, praying for permission to organize a Drainage District as provided in Chapter 24, Article 4, Revised Statute, 1923, to consist of the following described lands:

In Leocompton and Wakarusa Townships, Douglas County, Kansas:

Beginning at a point on the southerly bank of the Kansas River at low water mark in Lot Number One, Sec. 6, Twp. 12S., Range 19 E. of the 6th Principal Meridian 660 feet west of the easterly boundary of Sec. 6; thence southerly to the N. W. corner of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 7; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of the said subdivision to the S. W. corner thereof; thence, easterly along the subdivision line through Sec. 7 and 8 to the point where it intersects with the southerly boundary of the right of way of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company; thence, easterly along the said right of way line to the westerly boundary of Sec. 9; Thence, southerly along the said boundary to the S.
