After hearing all the evidence offered by the petitioners and after having investigated all the matters and facts fully in connection with this application, the Board does find that said Petition was signed by more than two-fifths of the resident tax payers of the district sought to be established:

And the Board finds that the lands included in the district described in said Petition are subject to damage and injury from certain water courses, the Kansas River, Sweezer's Branch, Baldwin Creek and Mud Creek, and that the improvement of the channel of the said water courses, the construction of levees, drains and other works are necessary to prevent such overflow, and such improvement will be conducive to the public welfare:

That said Petition is in conformity to the requirements of the law as found in Chapter 24, Article 4, Revised Statutes 1923, and that all the allegations of said Petition are true.

The Board of County Commissioners do here now declare the territory described in said Petition and map thereto attached as follows, to-wit:

In Leocompton and Wakarusa Townships, Douglas County, Kansas:

Beginning at a point on the southerly bank of the Kansas River at low water mark in Lot Number one, Sec. 6, Twp. 12 S. Range 19 E. of the 6th Principal Meridian 660 feet west of the easterly boundary of Sec. 6; thence southerly to the N. W. corner of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of the said subdivision to the S. W. corner thereof; thence, easterly along the subdivision line through Sec. 7 and 8 to the point where it intersects with the southerly boundary of the right of way of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company; thence, easterly along the said right of way line to the westerly boundary of Sec. 9; thence, southerly along the said boundary to the S. W. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9; thence easterly along the subdivision line to the S. E. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9; thence, S. 17° 37' E. 1379.9 feet, to the southerly boundary of Sec. 9; thence S. 35° 55' E. 797.93 feet; thence S 60° 00' E. 30.0 feet; thence S. 56° 40' E. 492.0 feet; to the north and south center line of Sec. 15; thence S. 68° 22' E. 739.0 feet; thence, S. 84° 22' E. 100.0 feet; thence S. 59° 22' E. 300.0 feet; thence S 55° 52' E. 447.5 feet; thence S. 78° 37' E. 421.0 feet; thence S. 88° 23' E. 836.74 feet to a point on the westerly boundary of Sec. 15; thence south along said boundary 538.15 feet to a point 423 feet N. of the quarter corner common to Sections 15 and 16; thence S. 89° 22' E. 771.26 feet; thence south to the east and west center line of Sec. 15; thence, easterly along said center line to the N. W. corner of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 15; thence southerly along the subdivision line to the S. W. corner of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$; thence easterly along the subdivision line through Sections 15 and 14 to the S. E. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14; thence northerly along the subdivision line to the south bank of the Kansas River at low water mark; thence westerly along the said south bank through Sections 14, 11, 10, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Twp. 12 South, Range 19 East to the point of beginning.

In Grant Township and the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

Beginning at a point 1320 feet west of the N. W. corner of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, Twp. 12 S., R. 19 E. of the 6th Principal Meridian; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of Sec. 2, to the point where said northerly boundary intersects with the northerly boundary of the right of way of the Union Pacific Railway Company; thence southeasterly along the said northerly boundary through Sections 2, 1 and 12 of the said Twp. and Range, and Sec. 7 of Twp. 12 S., R. 20 E. to the point where the said right of way line intersects with the east and west center line of Sec. 7; thence easterly along the said center line to the north and south center line of Sec. 7; thence southerly along the said center line to the N. W. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$; thence easterly along the subdivision line to the N. E. corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of Sec. 7 to the N. W. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8; thence southeasterly to the S. E. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of Sec. 17 to the N. E. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17; thence southerly along the north and south center line of Sec. 17 to the S. E. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ thereof; thence easterly to the N. E. corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of Sec. 17 to a point 70 rods north of the S. E. corner of Sec. 17; thence easterly parallel to the southerly boundary of Section 16 to the north and south center line of Sec. 16; thence southerly along said center line to the S. E. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16; thence easterly along the southerly boundary of Sec. 16 to the N. E. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21; thence southerly along the subdivision line to the N. W. corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21; thence easterly along the subdivision line to the N. E. corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21, which is also a point on the boundary line between Douglas and Leavenworth Counties; thence southerly along the said county boundary line to the northerly bank of the Kansas River at the low water mark; thence westerly and northerly along the said bank through Sections, 33, 32, 29, 30, 19 and 18 in Twp. S. R. 20 E. and Sections 13, 14, and 11, in Twp. 12 S., R. 19 E. to a point 1320 feet west of the north and south center line of Sec. 11, thence parallel to the said north and south center line to the southerly boundary of Sec. 2; thence northerly parallel and 1320 feet west of the north and south center line of Sec. 2 to the point of beginning.

The said described territory to constitute a corporation and the inhabitants within such bounds are hereby incorporated as a drainage district under the name of The Douglas County Kaw Drainage District of Douglas County, Kansas.
