Whereupon, the following resolution was presented:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY KANSAS FOR ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE FOR CLERK HIRE IN THE OFFICE OF COUNTY TREASURER AND COUNTY CLERK.

WHEREAS, it has become apparent and it is now the finding of the Board that the amounts now allowed by law for clerk hire in the offices of the County Treasurer and County Clerk are insufficient to expedite the business of the said two offices, and

WHEREAS, it is now the finding of the Board that the amount of \$1800.00 is necessary for clerk hire to expedite the business of the County Treasurer and \$1500.00 is necessary for clerk hire to expedite the business of the County Clerk,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in regular adjourned session this 7th day of August, 1935, that the sum of \$1800.00 be allowed for clerk hire for the office of County Treasurer in addition to that now allowed by law, and the sum of \$1500.00 be allowed for clerk hire in the County Clerk's office in addition to that now allowed by law and that notice of this fact be published in the official paper of Douglas County, Kansas in the manner provided by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these allowances shall be in effect one year from date this Resolution is published in the official county paper.

MINUTES OF JOINT ASSEMBLY  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
LEAVENWORTH AND DOUGLAS COUNTY  
August 6, 1935, Lawrence, Kansas.

Now on this 6th day of August, 1935, the Boards of Commissioners of Leavenworth County and Douglas County met in joint assembly for consideration of the repair of Eudora Bridge. The meeting was called at 11:30 A. M. The members of the two Boards all being present, and it is moved by Commissioner Chris Schaeke and seconded by Commissioner H. C. Short that the County Engineers of the two counties be directed to proceed to Topeka for the purpose of obtaining the approval of the State Highway Engineer, of new plans and specifications for the reconstruction of the Eudora Bridge.

Meeting to adjourn until 4 o'clock P. M. of this day.

At 4 P. M. the joint assembly of the Boards of Douglas and Leavenworth Counties reconvened, at which time the revised plans for the reconstruction of the Eudora Bridge are presented and it is the finding of the Board, the same have received the approval of the State Highway Engineer.
