COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

September 23, 1935

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At a special meeting of the Douglas County Commissioners, called by the County Clerk, U. S. G. Plank, all the Commissioners, the County Attorney, R. B. Stevens and the County Clerk, U. S. G. Plank were present. The specific object of the meeting was to complete details relative to the \$15,000,000 Bond issue to cover the Douglas County, Kansas share of the bridge repair expenses on the Eudora Bridge.

The following was presented by the County Clerk:

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RESOLUTION OF THE MARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, ANS AS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS FOR THE ONLY LF COST OF REPAIRING AND REBUILDING OF THE SUDDRA BRIDGE ON THE KAW RIVER BETWEEN DOUGLAS AND LEAVENWORTH COUNTIES.

WHEREAS the County Boards of Leavenworth County and Douglas County, Kansas did on the 12th day of February hold joint meeting in the rooms of the Douglas County Commissioners and discussed necessity for the repairing of the bridge across the Kaw River at Eudora, Kai , said bridge connecting the two counties, and

WHEREAS the Commissioners of the respective counties on the advice of the Engineers of the said Counties did satimate the moneys needed for said repairs to be \$30,000.00, and did prepare an application to be made to the 1935 legislature of the State of Kansas for authorization of a Bond issue in the sum of \$30,000.00 for the purpose of defraying the extenses of said repairs, and

WHEREAS the said 1935 legisla did pass an act, Chapter 253 Session Laws 1935, authorizing said joint count; to issue not to exceed \$30.000.00 in Bonds for the purpose afore mentioned, a

WHEREAS the Boards of the Counties of Leavenworth and Douglas in the State of Kansas in joint session assembled where 29th day of August, 1935, did receive and open bids from various contracting companies as per proper advertisement, and

WHEREAS all said bids were and the estimate of the County Engineers and were, therefore, rejected, and

WHEREAS under authority granted said Boards, Kansas Revised Statutes 1923, 68-1115, private contract was entered into with J. T. Constant, Contractor, for the completion of the work for the sum of \$28,054.83, and

WHEREAS said contract was properly executed and filed in the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, on September 7, 1935, and

WHEREAS Bonds for faithful performance of duty and completion of work was properly and legally executed and filed in the office of the County Clerk on the 7th day of September, 1935, and

WHEFEAS all legal requirements have been fully completed and the work on said repairs are now well underway,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in special session duly assembled on this 23rd day of September, 1935;

Section 1. That Eudora Kaw River Bridge Bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, in the sum of \$15,000.00, be and the same hereby are authorized by virtue of Article I, Chapter 10 Revised Statutes 1933 Supplement, State of Kansas, and all other laws of Kansas applicable thereto.

Said issue shall consist of thirty (30) bonds, numbered 1 to 30 inclusively, in the denomination of \$500.00 each, all of said bonds shall be dated October 1, 1935, and shall become due and payable serially as follows:

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of two and one-fourth per cent $(2\frac{1}{5})$ per annum, payable April 1 and October 1 in each year. Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer in Topeka, Kansas, Said bonds shall be signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Clerk, and shall have the seal of said County affixed thereto; and shall have attached interest coupons signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Clerk, but said interest coupons may be authenticated by lithographed facsimile signatures of said officers.
