SECTION 3. There shall be levied annually upon all the taxable property in said county a tax sufficient to pay said bonds and the interest thereon, as said bonds and interest become due.

SECTION 4. That all provisions of this resolution which are inconsistent or in conflict with any of the provisions of the Resolution of and as a substitution of such provisions in said Resolution heretofore adopted.

SECTION 5. Be it further resolved that the transcript of said bond issue be submitted to the State School Fund Commission as provided in Section 10-106 Revised Statutes, 1933 Supplement, and if said bonds be rejected, the same shall be advertised in the official paper and sold for cash at private sale at not less than par and accrued interest.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and adoption.
