

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

RESOLUTION

Whereas it has been customary to close the office of the County Treasurer for the first ten days of October for the purpose of preparing the annual financial statement, and

Whereas, there is this year a change of officers on the 8th of October, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County Treasurer's office be closed to the public for a ten-day period beginning September 27th and ending October 8th in order to complete the annual statement before the change of officers.

E. E. Trueblood, County Engineer, appeared before the Board asking for typeographical assistant, and named Miss Freda Alt as a suitable person to assist him. On motion and a proper second and unanimous vote, Mr. Trueblood was authorized to employ Freda Alt temporarily at a wage of \$13.50 per week.

S. S. Learned, County Treasurer, asked for the transfer of certain funds. The Board by unanimous vote ordered the following:

To transfer \$693.25 from the Emergency Relief Fund to the County Farm and Poor Fund to complete reimbursement made under order of December 5th, 1934. An error in listing the warrants issued for March, 1934, expenditures is hereby corrected and the County Farm Fund is hereby reimbursed for expenditures on budgeted relief made in anticipation of the emergency relief bond issue.

Preparatory to the annual balancing of the Treasurer's books, it is necessary for an order of the Board to cancel certain taxes that had been assessed erroneously. The Board, by proper motion properly seconded and an affirmative vote ordered the following:
