RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF DOUGLAS COUNTY KANSAS IN REFERENCE TO
THE SOUTH SIDE KAW DRAINAGE DISTRICT OF
DOUGLAS COUNTY KANSAS.

Now on this 23 day of September, 1935, a Petition having been presented by certain signers in the number of 45, which this Board now finds to constitute two-fifths of the tax payers residing in the District described in the said petition, including tax payers owning land in said District but residing in Douglas County, Kansas; and said Petition conforming in all things to Section 24-403, Revised Statutes 1923, and praying for the incorporation of the, THE SOUTH SIDE KAW DRAINAGE DISTRICT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY KANSAS;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in a regular called special meeting assembled this 23 day of September, 1935, that a hearing for said Petition be now fixed for the 1st day of Oct, 1935 at 10 o'clock A. M. before this Board, in the Courtroom of the Douglas County Courthouse and the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas is hereby authorized to give notice thereof by one publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Douglas County, at least five days before the day fixed for this hearing, at which time persons in said District may appear and show cause why said District should not be organized in the manner provided by law.

NOTICE OF HEARING OF PETITION FOR
ORGANIZATION OF THE SOUTH SIDE KAW
DRAINAGE DISTRICT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY KANSAS

Notice is hereby given that on the 23rd day of September, 1935, a Petition signed by Benjamin Neis, L. L. Kindred, Carl Perkins and other to the number of 45, was presented to the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas praying for permission to organize a Drainage District as provided in Chapter 24, Article 4, Revised Statutes 1923, to consist of the following described lands, to-wit:

EUDORA TOWNSHIP:

Beginning at a point on the southerly bank of the Kansas River at low water mark, and on the section line between Sections 26 and 27, Township 12 S., Range 21 E of the 6th Principal Meridian; thence southerly along said section line to the S. E. Corner of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, thence westerly along the southerly boundary of said subdivision to the S. W. corner thereof; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said subdivision to a point where it intersects the northerly boundary of the right-of-way of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said right-of-way through the sections 34, 33, and 4 to a point where it intersects the southerly bank of the Kansas River at low water mark; thence easterly along the southerly bank of said river through sections 4, 33, 28 and 27, Township 12 S., Range 21 E to the point of beginning.

WAKARUSA AND EUDORA TOWNSHIPS:

Beginning at a point on the southerly bank of the Kansas River at low water mark and on the northerly boundary of the right-of-way of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in Section 4, Township 13 S., Range 21 E of the 6th Principal Meridian; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said right-of-way through Sections 4, 5 and 6 to a point where it intersects the section line between sections 1 and 6; thence northerly along said section line to the township corner common to Township 12 S., Range 20 E; Township 12 S., Range 21 E; Township 13 S., Range 21 E; and Township 13 S., Range 20 E; thence westerly along the township line to the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner common to sections 33 and 4 of Township 12 S., Range 20 E, and Township 13 S., Range 20 E; thence southerly along the north and south center line of Section 4 to a point where it intersects the northerly boundary
