5. That the District so sought to be a ganized is described as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 13, RANGE 19, ALL IN DCUGIAS COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY, that all of the territory hereinbefore described, as defined by the boundaries of said description, be incorporated as a Drainage District, under the corporate name of BULL CREEK DRAINAGE DISTRICT, OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, and that said district be organized under the so-called 1905 Drainage District Law, being ARICLE 4, of CHAFTER 24 REVISED STATUTES OF KANSAS 1923, and as since amended.
