in the district hereinafter described, or owning land in said District and residing in Douglas County,

2. That the lands and property hereinafter described are subject to injury and damage from the overflow of a certain natural watercourse, the same being known as Bull Creek, said Bull Creek flowing into and through the center part of Section 33 described herein:

3. That the improvement of the channel of such watercourse, the construction and maintenance of levees, drains, or other works are necessary to prevent such overflow; and that such improvement or works will be conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare.

4. That it is the desire of your petitioners to organize a Drainage District under the provisions of ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 24 REVISED STATUTES OF KANSAS, 1923, and as since amended.

5. That the District so sought to be organized is described as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 13, RANGE 19, ALL IN DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY, that all of the territory hereinbefore described, as defined by the boundaries of said description, be incorporated as a Drainage District, under the corporate name of BULL CREEK DRAINAGE DISTRICT, OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, and that said district be organized under the so-called 1905 Drainage District Law, being ARTICLE 4, of CHAPTER 24 REVISED STATUTES OF KANSAS 1923, and as since amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular meeting assembled this 4th day of November, 1935, that a hearing for said Petition be now fixed for the 13th day of November, 1935 at 10 o'clock A. M. before this Board in the regular meeting room of the Board of Commissioners in the Douglas County Court House, and the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, is hereby authorized to give notice thereof by one publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Douglas County, Kansas, at least five days before the day fixed for this hearing, at which the persons in said District may appear and show cause why said District should not be organized in the manner provided by law.
