

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, during the year it has been necessary to make unanticipated bridge fund expenditures because of flood conditions in the early spring and summer which washed out many culverts and required a great amount of bridge repair;

AND WHEREAS, it now appears that the year's expenditures exceed the estimated budget by \$1,203.89 although there is a cash balance on hand of \$4,525.91;

AND WHEREAS, in anticipation of the budget limitations it was decided in November that some bridge work might be classed as a work project and funds were paid to that end from the Public Assistance Fund to the amount of \$776.96;

AND WHEREAS, a re-interpretation of the provisions for work relief in the Public Assistance Fund law has led to the conclusion that the amount of \$776.96 for bridge fund work could not be expended from the Public Assistance Fund;

AND WHEREAS, the cash balance in the bridge fund is sufficient to pay the necessary obligations and it is deemed inadvisable to issue bonds under Chapter 190 of the 1935 laws;

AND WHEREAS, Section 79-2935 of the 1933 Supplement provides that expenditures for emergencies can be made outside the regular budget appropriations;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, does hereby declare an emergency in the County Bridge Fund and does therefore order the County Clerk to transfer the charge \$776.96 in- correctly made against the Public Assistance Fund to the County Bridge Fund and to increase the 1935 Bridge Fund Budget by \$1,203.89.

Moved by Earl T. Black and seconded by Chris Schaaake that the resolutions be adopted and by unanimous vote of the Commissioners it was so ordered.

Wesley Brune, representing the Drainage Board of Directors of the Douglas County Kaw Drainage District asking the Commissioners to allow themselves to become the agency through which the Drainage Board might lease from the KERC 20 Fresno scrapers and two road plows for the purpose of making needed repairs on the Kaw River dikes which were damaged by the flood early in 1935. On motion and the proper second the Board allowed the Drainage Board to use its good offices in the rental of the above named equipment, said allowance being embodied in the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the organization known as KERC be and it is hereby requested to rent to Douglas County, Kansas, certain equipment described in form No. 131 of said organization, which a copy of this resolution accompanies, said equipment being described in said form as follows to wit:

20 fresnos, each 5 ft. in width, with evener
for each fresno.
2 road plows.

It being understood that said equipment is in turn to be released to the Douglas County Kaw Drainage District for their use. That this Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, does hereby assume all responsibility for said equipment.

Be it further resolved by this Board of County Commissioners that the said Board does hereby agree to arrange, at its expense, for transportation of said equipment from the warehouse of the KERC to the place where the same is to be used, and for the return of said equipment at the expiration of the service back to the KERC warehouse, from which it was obtained, all at the expense of the Douglas County. That it is understood that said equipment is to be used on WPA project D-16-538.
