WE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, Acting as VIEWERS of a road petitioned by L. L. O'Meara and others of Kanwaka Township, met, as heretofore determined and ordered by the Board, at the beginning point of the road as petitioned for to be altered on the 8th day of March, 1935 and proceeded to view the route of said road as prayed for in the petition, or as nearly so as we consider a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals as well as to the public if said road or any part thereof be established-altered-vacated-opened-closed for public use.

Further action and hearing on the petition was postponed to the 13th day of March, 1935, at which date interested parties were notified to appear.

All interested parties appeared before the County Commissioners on the above set date, and discussed the matter of damages but no definite was taken, and final action was deferred until some future date.

The route of said road was surveyed under our direction by E. E. Trueblood, County Surveyor, assisted by C. E. Redmond and Albert Cox, chairmen and Edgar Duver, marker. The report of survey, plat and field notes are hereto attached and are made part of this report and record of final action.
