WE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, Acting as VIEWERS of a road petitioned for by Mrs Lillie Ridley and others of Wakarusa and Kanwaka Townships met, as heretofore determined and ordered by the Board, at the beginning point of the road as petitioned for to be vacated, on the 11th day of January, 1936, and proceeded to view the route of said road as prayed for in the petition, or as nearly so as we consider a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals as well as to the public if said road or any part thereof be vacated for public use.

Further action and hearing on the petition was postponed to the ___ day of ___ 19___ at which date interested parties were notified to appear.
