J. F. Laughlin and thirteen others presented a petition for a road beginning: at Northwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section 15, T14S, R 20E of the 6th P. M., thence running East on the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. line One hundred (100) Rods.

This petition was favorably considered and the Board instructed the County Clerk to proceed in the usual manner to give notice of petition and hearing. Whereupon, the County Clerk caused the following road notice to be published in the Eudora News in the July 16th issue, which was the first issue of publication. This notice was to be followed by two other notices. The road notice follows:
