Counsel quoted from the opinion of the Attorney-General, Clarence V. Beck, relative to the issuing of bonds for the Eunora Bridge project by the two counties. A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES TO DOUGLAS AND LEAVENWORTH COUNTIES, KANSAS, TO ALD BY WAY OF GRANT IN FINANCING THE REPAIRING AND RECONSTRUCTING OF AN EXISTING BRILGE AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF JEITIES.

WHEREAS, the Boards of County Commissioners of Douglas and Leavenworth Counties, Kansas, are authorized by Chapter 253, Laws of Kansas, 1935, to enter into contracts for the purpose of improving or reconstructing bridges connecting said Counties and across navigable streams which form a line between said Counties and the necessary approach or approaches thereto;
