At a special meeting of the Douglas County Commissioners called by Chairman James F. Brass, at the request of the County Clerk, U. S. G. Plank, the following members were present: namely, Chairman James F. Brass, Commissioner Chris Schaake, Commissioner Earl T. Black and County Clerk U. S. G. Plank.

The meeting was called for the purpose of passing upon the county tax ${\tt levy}$ as provided by ${\tt law}_{\bullet}$

The County Clerk presented the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

CONCERNING TAX LEVIES FOR THE YEAR 1936 to PROVIDE FUNDS FOR COUNTY PURPOSES IN ACCORD WITH THE BUDGETED EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1937.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS assembled in special session this 25th day of August, 1936, that the following tax rates be set to raise funds for expenditures for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1937 and ending December 31, 1937 as set forth in the "budget and financial statement for the year 1936" adopted this 25th day of August, 1936:

On a county valuation of \$35,915,580.00 the following rates on county funds:

General Fund-----\$1.59 to raise \$57,105.77 Road Fund------ 372 to raise \$13,360.59 Bridge Fund------ 606 to raise \$21,764.84 County Farm and Poor Fund 2.00 to raise \$71,831.16 Bounty Fund------ .020 to raise \$718.31 Crippled Children Fund .060 to raise \$2,154.93 Special Bridge Fund .020 to raise \$718.31 Farm Bureau Fund-- .055 to raise \$1,975.35 County Fairs Fund .027 to raise \$969.72 County Bonds and Interest Fund .58 to raise \$20,831.03

The total levy for county purposes is \$5.33

In addition to regular county funds, the following rate is set up for County High School Tuition:

On a valuation of \$13,943,572 a rate of \$2.41 to raise \$33,604.00 in tex.
